Dear Parent/ Carer,

We have carefully considered the decision to close the Year 11 bubble and move to remote learning provision for our Year 11 students for the last day of term (26<sup>th</sup> March 2021). Parents and carers whose children are required to self-isolate have been contacted separately by school. If you have not received a separate letter from school then your child is not required to self-isolate.

This is a decision not taken lightly, but in considering the multiple positive cases of COVID recently reported in the year group and the number of students required to self-isolate, we consider a full move to remote learning (live lessons) to be not only the safest option, but an option which ensures consistent high quality learning to all Year 11.
