Uniform and Standards

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope this letter finds you safe and well. I am writing to you to inform you that your son/daughter is currently wearing trainers to school which is against the school Uniform and Standards policy. The policy states that:

“It is compulsory to wear a plain white shirt and school tie, plain black tailored trousers, which do not include jean material or leggings, and/or tailored skirt (appropriate length/non stretch) with black tights, plain black shoes or ankle boots (**no trainers** or trainer like footwear are permitted).”

I am sure you can appreciate that uniform is an important part of school life and prepares students for the rigour of work life, as well as it represents them and the school in the wider community. With that in mind, we ask that your son/daughter amends their footwear issue no later than **Monday April 12th**.

We have 2 revenues of **funding available** to support families who need it. In order to access that, you simply need to provide a receipt for the shoes purchased and you will be reimbursed up to £35. If you have no means of purchasing the shoes in the first place, we can do so on your behalf.

If your son/daughter has a **medical condition**, then we require an up to date note from a doctor which would allow the student to be exempt from wearing school shoes. If you have provided a medical note this academic year, then we will honour this until September 2021. Any historic medical notes will not be accepted.
